Make a Valentine Tree



February is a good time to make a Valentine tree in your room. Word Bird's Valentine's Day book has a Valentine tree that can be filled with Valentine words and messages. One class made their tree this way. The teacher brought a tree branch in a pot of earth into the classroom in early February. The children named it, "The Loving Tree." They made leaves of valentines and filled them with words. They were so pleased with their tree that they made pictures of it to take home.

Create Your Very Own Valentine Post Office

A large box with a big window is all you need to create a post office in your room. Children will decorate it themselves. They will bring small boxes from home for individual mail boxes and make their own stamps and valentines out of scraps of colored paper. When the post office is open, children can mail each other valentines. They will learn many new words as they write simple messages to each other.



Make A Creative Valentine Animal Park

Have you ever seen a giraffetine, a rabbitine, a whaletine or an elephantine? Kids will create a most interesting Valentine Animal Park with different size animals. They can name their animals and tell stories about them

Have a Valentine Puppet Show

Paper bag Valentine puppets with heart bodies and faces will encourage children to create a story about the King and queen of hearts. Where do they go on Valentine's Day? What do they do?
